  - (2) a farm ditch crossing of the drain at A-1 Stations 53+68, 66+39 and 79+77 and A1-2 Station 12+60;
  - (3) drainage inlet to carry excess surface flows from irrigation and waste water at A-1 Stations 43+00, 53+68, 66+40, 74+55 and 79+80;
  - (4) drain inlet for farm drains at A-1 Stations 57+00, 62+00, 69+00 and 77+00; and
