 The Union Pacific Railway Company
 The United States of America
 To all to whom these presents shall come. Greeting
 Whereas by the Act of Congress approved July 1-1862 and July
 2-1864 "to aid in the construction of a railroad and telegraph line
 from the Missouri River to the Pacific Ocean and to secure to the
 Government the use of the same for postal, military and other purposes"
 authority is given to the Union Pacific Railroad Company to construct
 a railroad and telegraph line under certain conditions and stipulations
 as expressed in said acts; and provision is made for granting
 to said company every alternate section of public land designated
 by odd numbers to the amount of two alternate sections per mile;

on each side of the said railroad on the line thereof and within the limits of twenty miles on each side of said road not sold, reserved or otherwise disposed of by the United States, and to which a pre-emptive Homestead claim may not have attached at the time the line of said road is definitely fixed. And Whereas, an official statement bearing date November 2, 1869, from the Secretary of the Interior has been filed in the General Land Office showing that the Commissioners appointed by the President under provisions of the sixth section of the said act of Congress aforesaid, July 2, 1864, have reported & know that the line of railroad and telegraph from Omaha in the State of Nebraska westward to Ogallala in the Territory of Dakota and known as the Union Pacific Railroad has been constructed and fully completed and equipped in the manner prescribed by the act of Congress aforesaid.

And Whereas certain tract of land duly located under the acts aforesaid by the duly authorized agent of the said Union Pacific Railroad, now known as the Union Pacific Railway Company as shown by his original lists of petitions approved by the local offices and on file in this office.

And Whereas the said tract of land is contiguous to the constructed line of road and are particularly described as follows:

North of base line and East of 9th Lake Meridian

State of Dakota

Township Five Range One

All of section one containing six hundred and forty acres and eighty-one hundredths of an acre. All of section eleven containing six hundred and fifty acres; all of section thirteen containing six hundred and forty acres; all of section twenty-three containing six hundred and forty acres; the east half of the North East quarter - the North West quarter, the East half of the South West quarter and the North half of the South East quarter of section twenty-five containing four hundred acres. The North half of the North East quarter, the South West quarter of the South East quarter, the North West quarter of the South East quarter, the South half of the South East quarter and the East half of section twenty-one containing five hundred and thirty-one all of section thirty-five containing six hundred and forty acres.

Township Three Range Two

The East half of section one containing three hundred and nineteen acres and twenty four hundredths of an acre. All of section three containing one hundred and thirty two acres and forty eight hundredths of an acre. All of section five containing six hundred and thirty eight acres and thirty two hundredths of an acre. All of section nine containing six hundred and forty acres. The West half of section eleven containing three hundred and twenty acres. The North East quarter of the North West quarter and the South half of the North West quarter of section thirteen containing one hundred and twenty acres. All of section fifteen containing six hundred and forty acres. The South half of the North West quarter and the South half of section twenty three containing four hundred acres. the South half of the South East quarter of section twenty five containing eighty acres. The East half of the North West quarter and the East half of section twenty seven containing four hundred acres.

All of section one containing six hundred and thirty six acres and eighty hundredths of an acre. All of section three containing six hundred and forty acres and eighty hundredths of an acre. All of section five containing six hundred and forty seven acres and twenty hundredths of an acre. All of section eleven containing six hundred and forty acres. All of section thirteen containing six hundred and forty acres. All of section fifteen containing six hundred and forty acres. the North half of section twenty three containing three hundred and twenty acres. part of North half of section twenty three containing two hundred and forty acres.

Township Two Range Three

All of section one containing eight hundred and forty six acres and eighty two hundredths of an acre. All of section three containing eight hundred and seventy two acres. All of section eleven containing six hundred and forty acres. All of section fifteen containing six hundred and forty acres. The North East quarter of section fifteen containing one hundred and eighty acres.

All of section twenty-three containing six hundred and forty acres.
 All of section twenty-five containing eight hundred and forty acres. All of
 section twenty-seven containing six hundred and forty acres. All
 of section thirty-three containing six hundred and forty acres.
 All of section thirty-five containing six hundred and forty acres.

Township Three Range Three

The lots numbered three and four, the East half of the South
 East quarter and the South East quarter of section nineteen
 containing three hundred and forty acres and sixteen hundredths
 of an acre.

The said tract of land as described in the foregoing
 make the aggregate area of seventy-five thousand four hundred
 and forty-four acres and eighty hundredths of an acre (75:544.80)

Now know ye that the United States of America
 in consideration of the premises and pursuant to the said acts of
 Congress, I have given and granted and by these presents do
 give and grant unto the said Union Pacific Railway Company,
 formerly the Union Pacific Railroad Company and to its assigns
 the tract of land herein as aforesaid, and described in the foregoing
 yet excluding and excepting from the transfer by these presents
 all mineral lands should any such be found to exist in the tract
 described in the foregoing, but this exclusion and exception according
 to the terms of the Statute shall not be construed to include coal and
 iron land.

To have and to hold the said tract with the
 appurtenances therof unto the said Union Pacific Railway
 Company and to its successors and assigns forever with
 the exclusion and exception aforesaid.
