Deed of Right of Way

Oborn and Martha Oborn his wife of Union, Utah grantor for the sum of Two Dollars here by convey and warrant to Murray City, a municipal corporation, of the State of Utah, its successors and assigns grantee a Right-of-Way for a transmission line, consisting of poles, or other supports and wires for the transmission of electrical power, over and across the property hereinafter described, and the right to construct, operate and perpetually maintain, said transmission line, over and across the following described property, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah.

The property of said grantor located in the N.W. Quarter of Sec. 29, Township Two South Range One East, Salt Lake Base and meridian, according to the line as surveyed and indicated by stakes set in the ground showing position for poles.

Said transmission line shall be constructed and maintained substantially along the following line, running N 66° 40' W through said grantor's property.

Together with the right to enter upon said premises along the route of said transmission line for the purpose of erecting the poles and transmission line, and thereafter to enter upon said line, when necessary for the purpose of maintaining, inspecting, repairing, and reconstructing the same.

Upon the conditions, however that the said City, its Successors and assigns, shall pay to the said grantor their heirs, successors and assigns, any and all damages that may be at any time, occasioned by the owner of said line, its agents or servants, to the growing crops or premises of the ^{of the} first part, their successors and assigns, while engaged in the construction, reconstruction, inspection, or repairing of said poles or said transmission line.
