Deed of Right-of-Way

Catherine Montero and Conrad Stolliker, his wife
to Union Utah Grantors, for the sum of \$ 24.50 Dollars, hereby convey and warrant
to Murray City, a municipal corporation, of the State of Utah, its successors and
assigns, Grantee a right-of-way for a transmission line, consisting of poles, or
other supports, and wires, for the transmission of electrical power over and
across the property, hereinbefore described, and the right to construct, operate and
perpetually maintain said transmission line over and across the following de-
scribed property in Salt Lake County, State of Utah:

The property located in the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4, Sec 34 and the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4
See 34, T. 2 S. R. 18 E. L. 33 + M. as owned by grantors.

Said transmission line shall be constructed and maintained substantially
along the following line. Running N 54° W across the south western portion of

corporation, of the State of Utah, its successors and assigns, grantors, a right
of way for a transmission line, consisting of poles, or other supports and wires, for
the transmission of electrical power, over and across the property hereinbefore
described, and the rights to construct, operate and perpetually maintain, said
transmission line, over and across the following described property, in Salt Lake
County, State of Utah.

Said transmission line shall be constructed and maintained substantially,

along the following line, running in a north-westerly direction across grantor's property as located and staked on the ground.

Wither with the right to enter upon said premises along the route of said transmission line for the purpose of erecting the poles and transmission line and thereafter to enter upon said line, when necessary for the purpose of maintaining, inspecting, repairing, and reconstructing the same.
