After the meeting had been duly called to order and the minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved, the following proceedings, among others, were duly had and taken:

After considering all comments both in favor of and against the creation of the North Fork Special Service District, the Commission, upon the motion made by Yukus Y. Inouye and seconded by Kenneth J. Pinegar, unanimously approved the deletion of the following areas from the proposed North Fork Special Service District:

Brickerhaven

J. R.'s Haven

Big Pine Canyon

Stewart Cascade Lands Plat B

The description of the boundaries of the North Fork

Special Service District as revised is set forth in Schedule

A, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference

made a part hereof.

The Commission further limited the purposes of said District to water and fire control services thereby deleting sewage, drainage, flood control, garbage, hospital, transportation and recreation services from said District.

The following resolution was then introduced by Commissioner Inouye:

### RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH FORK SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT AS AMENDED AND TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AS SET FORTH IN THE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CREATE THE DISTRICT, AS AMENDED.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman and Board of Commissioners of Utah County, Utah:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Utah

County, Utah, believe that the public health, convenience
and necessity require the construction of water and fire
control improvements identified and described in the Notice
of Intention concerning the establishment of the North Fork
Special Service District, which notice has been published as
required by law.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners has heretofore considered each and every protest filed and has heard
each and every person who wished to be heard in protest
against the creation of the District or the construction of
any of the improvements therein or on any other matter
pertinent to said Special Service District. The names of the
protestants appearing at this hearing, and the description of
their property are as follows:

Section 3. The improvements proposed and described in the .

Notice of Intention to create said Special Service District as herein amended are hereby authorized, and the North Fork Special Service District is hereby created, the boundaries of which have been revised as above set forth.

Section 4. The Board of County Commissioners will receive and consider further written protests against the creation of the North Fork Special Service District or the proposed improvements therein for twenty-one (21) days following this meeting or until 10:00 a.m. on October 28, 1977. The creation of said District pursuant to the adoption of this resolution shall remain in effect unless the Board determines as of October 28, 1977, that more than 50% of the qualified voters within the revised boundaries of the proposed District oppose creation of said District. In that event, the Commission shall meet again in regular session to reaffirm the establishment of the District, modify the boundaries or purposes of said District, or rescind this resolution creating said District.

Section 5. The membership of the Administrative Control Board of said Special Service District shall consist of seven (7) members of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint the initial seven (7) members of said Administrative Control Board which it is entitled to appoint, three members to serve two year terms and the other four members to serve four year terms, the determination of who shall serve in each category to be made by lot.

Said terms shall commence on January 1, 1979, which is the next succeeding date

that the terms of office commence for members of the Board of Commissioners. The initially appointed members of the Administrative Control Board shall serve an additional term commencing on the date of appointment and continuing until the regular commencement of the above-specified terms.

Vacancies of the seven appointed members of said Board, other than by expiration of term, shall be filled by appointment of the Board of Commissioners for the unexpired term of the member whose vacancy is filled.

Section 6. Appointment of the initial membership of the Administrative Control Board shall be made by the Board of County Commissioners at a future Commission meeting.

Commissioner Pinegar seconded the motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution. The Resolution was thereupon put to a vote and unanimously adopted on the following recorded vote:


