WARRANTY DEED

UNION PACIFIC LAND RESOURCES CORPORATION, a corporation of the State of Nebraska, GRANTOR, hereby conveys and warrants to DFB BUILDING COMPANY, a partnership, GRANTEE, for the sum of one and no/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following-described tract of land situate in City of Salt Lake, County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, to-wit:

A parcel of land, being a portion of Lot 8, Block 62, Plat "A", Salt Lake City Survey, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, State of Utah, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of said Lot 8 of said block;

thence S. 0° 00' 59" E., a distance of 115.07 feet, along the east line of said lot to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence continuing along said east line, S. 0° 00' 59" E., a distance of 49.97 feet, to the southeast corner of that certain parcel of land heretofore conveyed by Carrie Keyting to Oregon Short Line Railroad by Warranty Deed dated November 2, 1903, O.S.L. L.P. D.A. No. 2401;

thence S. 89° 58' 10" W., a distance of 115.5 feet;

thence N. 0° 00' 59" W., a distance of 165.04 feet, to the north line of said Lot 8;

thence along said North line, N. 89° 58' 10" E., a distance of 59.22 feet, to a point on a non-tangent circular curve, concave south-westerly, from which the center bears S. 58° 58' 38" W., a distance of 743.615 feet;

thence southeasterly along said curve an arc distance of 128.24 feet, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing an area of 16,061 square feet, more or less.

Together with all rights of way, easements, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

EXCEPTING from this grant and reserving unto the GRANTOR, its successors and assigns forever, all minerals and all mineral rights of every kind and character now known to exist or hereafter discovered, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, oil and gas and rights thereto, together with the sole, exclusive and perpetual right to explore for, remove and dispose of said minerals by any means or methods suitable to the GRANTOR, its successors or assigns, but without entering upon or using the surface of the lands hereby conveyed, and in such manner as not to damage the surface of said lands or to interfere with the use thereof by the GRANTEE, its successors or assigns.

The above-described property is conveyed subject to conditions, restrictions, reservations, easements and encumbrances of record or open and obvious on the ground.
