THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA: To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, the same lands described in actual settlers on the Public Domain, and the sole supplemental thereto, the claim of Torquato Gatti, has been established and said lands, in conformity to law, for the

Northwest Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the southeast quarter of Section twenty-eight and the North Half of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section thirty-four in Township seven north and Range six east of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing six hundred forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said land, on file in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE.

THE SAID LANDS: That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of land above described; to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereon, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever, subject to a valid and assumed water right for mining, agricultural, stock raising, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water right, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local custom, laws and regulations of such State, and as may be determined from the laws hereinafter provided. Except for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States, accepting and reserving, however, to the United States all the coal and other minerals in the lands so granted and patented, together with the right to prospect for, mine and remove the same pursuant to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 29, 1850 (9 Stat. 496).

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RIGHT OF WAY DEED

No. 2376: Ed. Corina and Eva Corina, his wife, grantors of Tooele County of Rich, State of Utah, hereby grants, bargains and sells to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of Fifty, (\$50.00) Dollars, the following described right of way across the grantors' land in Rich County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as U.S. Highway No. 89-B across the grantors' land in the NE 1/4 of Section 14, T. 9 N., R. 7 E., S. 13 E. said right of way is an irregular strip of land bounded on the northwesterly side by a line 20 ft. distant westerly northwesterly from the center line of survey of said project and bounded on the south and west sides by the present highway right of way. Said center line is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east boundary line of said grantors' land and said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 35471.4 which point is 273.1 ft. south and 871.1 ft. west from the north quarter corner of said Section 14; thence northerly and to the right along the arc of a 271.1 ft. radius curve 162.2 ft. (center) to said center at the point of beginning known as 35472.2 (point); to the intersection of said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 35472.2 and the center boundary line of said project, which point is 200.1 ft. south and 125.7 ft. west from the north quarter corner of said Section 14, as shown at the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah.
