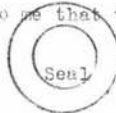

John A. Webster and Fannie B. Webster, his wife, grantors of Kayeville, Davis County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, re-location, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the Grantee, and four poles or towers, with the necessary stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, under, upon and across a tract of land fifty (50) feet in width, belonging to the Grantor, in Davis County, Utah, described as follows:

Twenty-five (25) feet on each side of a line:

Commencing on the Southeasterly boundary of Grantor's land 1060 feet West of a point 2200 feet South of the Northeast corner Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, S. L. M.-thence running North 37°26' West 1910 feet to the Northwesterly boundary of Grantor's land; all contained within the East 1/2 of Section 5, Said Township and Range.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

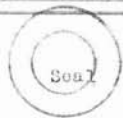

Twenty-five (25) feet on each side of a line:

Commencing on the Southeasterly boundary of Grantor's land 690 feet South of a point 425 feet East of the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner Section 5, Township 3 North Range 1 West, S. L. M.-thence running North 37° 55' West 870 feet to North boundary of Grantor's land; all contained within the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 5, said Township and Range.
