MARK A. WILSON, McKENZIE J. WILSON and DOROTHY WILSON
Grantors, of Utah County, State of Utah, do hereby convey and warrant to MOUNTAIN FUEL
SUPPLY COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Utah, Grantee, its successors and assigns, for
the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) in hand paid and other good and valuable consideration,
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, a right-of-way and easement 16.0 feet in width to lay,
maintain, operate, repair, inspect, protect, remove and replace pipelines, valves, valve boxes and
other gas transmission and distribution facilities (hereinafter collectively called "facilities")
through and across the following-described land and premises situated in the County of Utah, State
of Utah, to-wit:

Land of the Grantor located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 5 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian;

the centerline of said right-of-way and easement shall extend through and across the above-described land and premises as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point North 377.42 feet and West 1207.71 feet and North 0°01'24" East 228.64 feet and North 89°11'29" West 296.56 feet from the South Quarter corner of Section 24, Township 5 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, said point being on Grantors' north property line; thence South 0°08'23" East 177.00 feet; thence South 89°11'29" East 225.00 feet;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto said Mountain Fuel Supply Company, its successors and assigns, so long as such facilities shall be maintained, with the right of ingress and egress to and from said right-of-way to maintain, operate, repair, inspect, protect, remove and replace the same. During temporary periods, Grantee may use such portion of the property along and adjacent to said right-of-way as may be reasonably necessary in connection with construction, maintenance, repair, removal or replacement of the facilities. Grantors shall have the right to use said premises except for the purposes for which this right-of-way and easement is granted to Grantee, provided such use does not interfere with the facilities or any other rights granted to Grantee hereunder.

Grantors shall not build or construct, nor permit to be built or constructed, any building or other improvement over or across said right-of-way, nor change the contour thereof, without written consent of Grantee. This right-of-way shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of Grantors and the successors and assigns of Grantee, and may be assigned in whole or in part by Grantee.

It is hereby understood that any parties securing this grant on behalf of Grantee are without authority to make any representations, covenants or agreements not herein expressed.
