

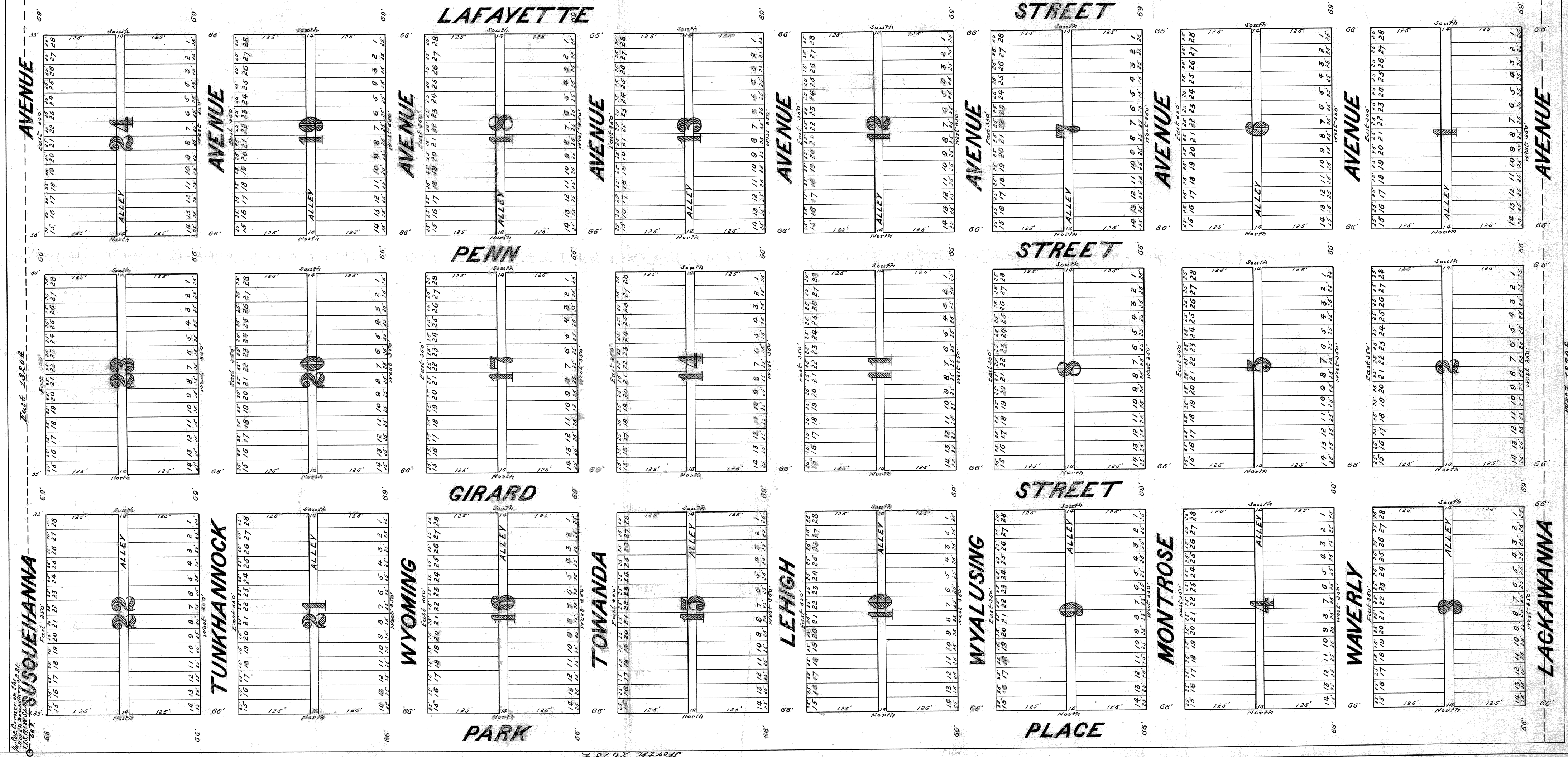
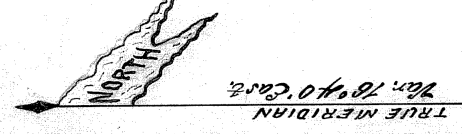
# MAP OF

 North East 1/4 of Section 21 Township 1 South Range  
 1 East of West 1st Meridian and containing an  
 area of 81 Acres is correctly made from an actual  
 survey made by me and others correctly  
 the actual connection of said plat with the  
 Townships 1 South Range 1 East of West 1st Meridian  
 and also with and describe, say the course of  
 ground lines and all situated by their boundaries
