



To All Whom These Presents Shall Come, Greeting:
Under and by virtue of Section 42, Chapter 64 of
the Session Laws of 1899, of the State of Utah, as
amended by Chapter 35, Session Laws of 1901, and by
Authority of a resolution of the State Board of Land
Commissioners of the State of Utah, dated December
3rd, 1904.

Witnesseth that the said State Board of Land
Commissioners, without compensation, it
appearing to the judgment of the said State Board
of Land Commissioners that no damage will result
therefrom, by virtue of the power and authority vested
in it by the laws of the State of Utah in such
cases made and provided, does hereby grant and
convey in the name and by the authority of the
State of Utah, unto The Telluride Power Company, a

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Colorado corporation, grantee, and to its successors and assigns, forever, rights of way for the erection, maintenance and operation of lines for the transmission of electric energy and for telephone purposes, on, over and across the parcels of land herein after described. This grant shall apply only to those interests in said parcels of land which are now held, possessed and owned by the State of Utah therein and is given subject to all existing rights of any and all persons or corporations.

Said parcels of land, situated in Utah County, Utah, are described as follows:

Section 16, Tp. 5 S. R. 2 E.; N. 2 U. $\frac{1}{4}$, S. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30; E. $\frac{1}{2}$ N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, Tp. 4 S. R. 1 W. S. S. m.
S. $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 24, Tp. 4 S. R. 1 W. S. m.; S. 2 U. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, Tp. 4 S. R. 1 E. S. m.


