 Precinct Salt Lake County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to James Johnson, grantee of the  
 same place for the sum of One Hundred (\$100<sup>00</sup>) Dollars, the following described tract of land  
 in Salt Lake County, State of Utah. Commencing at the South West corner of the South West  
 Quarter of Section Thirty three (33) Township two (2) South of Range one (1) West Salt Lake Meridian  
 running thence East fifty (50) rods thence South fifty seven and six tenths ( $57\frac{6}{10}$ ) rods, thence  
 West fifty (50) rods, thence North fifty seven and six tenths ( $57\frac{6}{10}$ ) rods to the place of beginning,  
 containing eighteen (18) acres of land.

No 106895 To all to whom these presents shall come greeting.

Whereas Daniel St. Swan of Salt Lake County Utah Territory, has duly applied  
 in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office  
 at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by  
 the said Daniel St. Swan according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of  
 April 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands"  
 and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South West Quarter of Section two in Township  
 three South of Range two West of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory, containing one hun-  
 dred and eighty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to  
 the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased  
 by the said Daniel St. Swan.

I now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and  
 in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given  
 and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Daniel St. Swan and  
 to his heirs the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all  
 the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto  
 belonging unto the said Daniel St. Swan and to his heirs and assigns forever. Subject  
 to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or  
 other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water  
 rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions  
 of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and re-  
 move his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the  
 hereby granted as aforesaid by law.

This Deed, made the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety six, between Marshall Stacker and Julia S. Stacker, his wife, of the City of Indianapolis County of Bartholomew and State of Indiana, parties of the first part; and Sarah A. Stacker of the County of Shayen and State of Nebraska, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of three Thousand and (3000.00) Dollars lawful money to them in hand paid by the party of the second part; by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, convey and quit claim unto the party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described premises and parcels of land situated in Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah to wit: - All of Lots the fourteenth, fifteenth and eighteen (14, 15 & 16) of Sherry Park Addition to Salt Lake City, according to the recorded plat thereof.

Together with all tenements, hereditaments, privileges & performances thereunto belonging or therewith used and enjoyed and all legal equitable or homestead rights of the parties of the first part in or to said premises.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever. And the said Marshall Stacker and Julia S. Stacker parties of the first part, hereby except with the party of the second part, her heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized of said premises in fee simple free from liens and encumbrances except a certain mortgage in the sum of Eleven Thousand (1100.00) Dollars and the accrued interest thereon, that they have full power to sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid and the legal title to said premises and a quiet and peaceable possession thereof against all lawful claims whatsoever under the party of the second part, her heirs and assigns. And the said Julia S. Stacker hereby covenants with the party of the second part, that she has legal authority to relinquish and bar the above right in said premises and she hereby relinquishes and forever bars the same.
