Pole Line Easement

Mrs. Gina H. Wright, a widow, Grantor, of Salt Lake County, Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and one pole, with the necessary guy, stub, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Commencing on the west boundary of Grantor's land 2530 feet west of a point 2270 feet north of the southeast corner, Section 36, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, S. 2. T. 1. - thence running South 73° 31' East 265 feet to east boundary of Grantor's land, all contained within the Northwest 1/4 of Southeast 1/4, Section 36, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, S. 2. T. 1.

Together with full right of ingress and egress for all purposes of maintenance, inspection, repair, alteration and replacement of said circuits, supports and attachments.
