TERMINATION OF TEMPORARY BASEMENT

WHEREAS, the United States, Grantee, obtained a temporary easement from Ray L. Frost, a single man, and Thomas Leland Frost and Ruth S. Frost, his wife, Grantors, during the construction of Davis Aqueduct, Weber Basin Project, which easement was to be released when the construction work was completed through the easement area.

NCW, THEREFORE, the United States acting pursuant to the Act of Congress of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388) having completed the construction work of Davis Aqueduct, and appurtenant structures through the certain easement area, does hereby release, terminate, and discharge the temporary easement obtained from the Grantors named in that certain deed dated June 5, 1954, and recorded in Book 68, Page 165, on the 22nd day of July 1954, in the Davis County Recorder's Office and described as follows:

A strip of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NWLNWL) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Four (4) North, Range One (1) West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Two Hundred Twenty (220) feet wide and included between two lines extended to the property lines and everywhere distant One Hundred Twenty (120) feet on the right or Westerly side and One Hundred (100) feet on the left or Easterly side of that portion of the following described centerline of what is known as the Davis Aqueduct from Station 288+75.0 to Station 295+47.1 measured at right angles or radially thereto; said centerline is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Station 288+75.0, a point on the North line of the Grantors' property, from which point the Northwest corner of said Section 25 bears North 75°14' West Ten Hundred Six and One-tenth (1006.1) feet, and running thence South 1°00' West Two Hundred Six and Two-tenths (206.2) feet; thence along a regular curve to the left with a radius of Four Hundred (400) feet for an arc distance of Eighty-two and Eight-tenths (82.8) feet; thence South 10°52' Bast Three Hundred Eighty-three and One-tenth (383.1) feet to Station 295+47.1 of said Aqueduct centerline, a point on the South line of the Grantors' property, from which point the Northwest corner of said Section 25 bears North 48°19' West Fourteen Hundred Seven and Nine-tenths (1407.9) feet, containing 3.5 scres, more or less; excepting herefrom 0.6 of an acre, more or less, which is covered by perpetual easements, and described as follows:

Beginning at Station 288+75.0, a point on the Worth line of the Grantors' property, from which point the Morthwest corner of said Section 25 bears North 75°14' West Ten Hundred Six and One-tenth (1006.1) feet, and running thence South 1°00' West Two Hundred Six and Two-tenths (206.2) feet; thence along a regular curve to the left with a radius of Four Hundred (400) feet for an arc distance of Righty-two and Right-tenths (82.8) feet; thence South 10°52' East Three Hundred Eighty-three and One-tenth (383.1) feet to Station 295+47.1 of said Aqueduct centerline, a point on the South line of the Grantors' property, from which point the Northwest corner of said Section 25 bears North 48°19' West Fourteen Hundred Seven and Nine-tenths (1407.9) feet.

This release shall not be construed to release or affect in any manner the perpetual easement granted by said Grantors in the above-referenced deed.
