THIS EXHIBIT A is attached to and made a part of that certain Assignment dated <u>NEC 2 8 1990</u>, from MUELLER INDUSTRIES, INC., a Delaware Corporation, successor in interest to Sharon Steel Corporation by Agreement of Merger dated effective <u>NEC 2 8 1990</u>, Assignor, to MINING REMEDIAL RECOVERY COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, Assignee, covering described parcels of land situated in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, to-wit:
