- (b) Ownership of and title to various easements, perpetual in duration, each said easement being individual and separate and apart and independent of and from any other easement hereby conveyed, whether or not any area covered by any such easement physically overlaps or partially overlaps another such area or otherwise, upon and across the real property underlying each individual railroad track shown marked green on Exhibits B, C, D, E, and F, each of which said easements shall be 17 feet in width measured 8-1/2 feet on each side of the center line of each individual track shown marked in solid green on said Exhibits B, C, D, E, and F, and each of which said easements shall extend in length along the full and entire length of each individual railroad track shown marked in solid green on











said Exhibits B, C, D, E, and F, the total areas of all said easements being colored in yellow and being otherwise marked and defined on said Exhibits B, C, D, E, and F and which said easements shall be for the purpose of enabling said grantees, their lessees, successors, and assigns to operate, maintain, repair, renew and reconstruct said railroad tracks and trackage.
