Rachel Elizabeth Elliot grantor of Clearfield, County of Davis State of Utah, hereby grants, bargains and sells to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of One Hundred Fifty 00/00 DOLLARS, the following described right of way across the grantor land in Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 114-C across the grantor's land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., S.L.M. Said right of way is contained within a parcel of land 50 ft. wide, 50 ft. on the west side of the center line of survey of said project. Said center line is described as follows:

RIGHT OF WAY DEED

Jennie R. Keogh grantor of Ogden, County of Weber State of Utah, hereby grants, bargains and sells to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of Two Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS, the following described right of way across the grantor land in Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 114-C across the grantors land in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, T. 5 N., R. 2 W., S. L. M. Said right of way is contained within a strip of land 50 ft. wide, on the west side of the center line of survey of said project. Said center line is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of said NE 1/4 of Section 35 and said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 239+63.5, which point is also the east 1/4 corner of said Section 35; thence N. 0°04'E., 236.5 feet; thence N. 0°13'W., 431.0 feet to the intersection of said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 296+31 and the north boundary line produced of said grantors land, which point is 1979.0 ft. south along the east line of said Section 35 from the NE corner of said Section 35, as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah. Above described tract of land contains 0.77 acre, of which 0.49 acre is now occupied by the existing highway.

Balance 0.28 acre.

In executing this deed, the grantor hereby grants to the State Road Commission of Utah permission to relocate and reconstruct within the grantors land and outside the limits of above described right of way, all irrigation ditches existing within said limits of above described right of way.

The grantor also grants to said State Road Commission permission to extend onto said grantor's land and outside the limits of the above described right of way all cut and/or fill slopes made necessary by the grading for sidewalks upon the right of way of said project.
