EXCEPTING and reserving to the Grantor, its successors or assigns, the right of access to the nearest roadway of said highway over and across the easterly right of way line for one 50.0 foot section, which said section centers at a point directly opposite Highway Engineer Station 144+50.0.

Any and all water rights pertaining to the above described land are hereby reserved by the Grantor, and the Grantee shall not be liable for any water assessments now due or which shall become due.
