AN ORDINANCE VACTING AND SETTING ASIDE A PORTION OF PLAT "A", PARKWAY SUBWAY SUBDIVISION INCLUDING THAT PORTION OF OF 230 WEST STREET BETWEEN 1625 NORTH AND 1700 NORTH STREETS IN PROVO CITY, UTAH, AUTHORIZING RETURN OF THE PROPERTY TO THE SUCCESSORS IN INTEREST OF THE ORIGINAL GRANTORS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PROVO CITY, UTAH:

SECTION I:

WHEREAS, William G. Lichfield and Beulah M.

Lichfield, his wife, as owners, dedicated a subdivision in

Provo City, Utah County, State of Utah, designated as Plat

"A", Parkway Subdivision and caused a map and plat thereof to

be approved by the City and recorded in the records of Utah

County as entry no. 13518-56 on 25th day of September, 1956,

which map and plat is designated in the records of the Utah

County Recorder as Map no. 406 and,

WHEREAS, portions of the said subdivision have heretofore been vacated and,

WHEREAS, the present owners of the property C & M Magleby Properties, a partnership, is desirous of vacating the undeveloped portion of the subdivision, together one portion of 230 West Street between/625 North 1700 North; and

WHEREAS, the successors in interest have petitioned the City to vacate the street for the reason that it serves no useful purpose and that the subdivision plat will not be utilized as a subdivision, but will be developed as commercial

property and they are therefore desirous of having the street property deeded back in order to build on it for future building site, and;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, the City Traffic
Department and Board of Commissioners of Provo City are
satisfied that the street petitioned to be vacated serves no
useful purposes and that the portion of the plat sought to be
desired is in the best interest of the residents of the City
and that the street once it is vacated should be reconveyed
by the City to the successors in interest of the original
grantors;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Provo City hereby ordain, that portion of Plat "A", Parkway Subdivision as shown on the records of Utah County, designated as Lots 3 through 11 inclusive, of Block 2, together with all of lot 2 of the same block, with the exception of that portion heretofore conveyed to Glen R. Williams and also, Lots 1 through 5 inclusive of Block 3 of the same Plat and Subdivison are hereby vacated.

In addition, that portion of 230 West Street extending from the North right of way line of 625 North Street to the South right of way line of 1700 North Street as shown on the original plat is hereby vacated and set aside and the mayor is authorized to reconvey the said property by quitclaim deed to C & M Magleby Properties, a partnership.

The County Recorder of Utah County is authorized upon recordation of this ordinance to show the said street and portion of the subdivision to be vacated.

SECTION II:

This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after it is published, or thirty days after is it passed, whichever date is later.
