## A M E N D E D R E S T R I C T I O N S

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned owners of the following described property situated in Weber - County, Utah, to-wit:

AMENDED

All lots inclusive in SOUTHCREST/SUBDIVISION according to the official plat thereof recorded in the office of the Recorder of Weber County, State of Utah.

ARE desirous of creating restrictions and covenants affecting said property.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the undersigned hereby declare the property hereinabove mentioned subject to the following restrictions and covenants:

- 1. No lot shall be used except for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, placed, or premitted to remain on any lot other than one detached single family dwelling not to exceed two stories in height and a private garage or carport for not more than two cars.
- 2. No building shall be erected, placed or altered on any building plot in the above described property until the building plans, specifications, and plot plan showing the location of such building have been approved in writing as to comformity and harmony of external design with exisiting structures in the said property, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation, by a committee composed of J. RICHARD ANDERSEN, MACK J. MADSEN, and BRIGHAM D. MADSEN or by a representive designed by a majority of the members of the said committee. In the event of the death or resignation of any member of said committee the remaining member, or members of the said committee, shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such designs and locations within thirty days after said plans and specifications have been submitted to, it, or in any event, if no suit to enjoin the erection of such building or the making of such alterations has been commenced prior to the completion thereof, such approval will not be required and this covenant will be deemed to have been fully complied with. Neither the members of such committee, nor its designated representative shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this covenant. The powers and duties of such committee, and of its designated representative, shall cease on or after January 1, 1963. Thereafter, the approval described in this covenant shall not be required unless, prior to said date and effective thereon, a written instrument shall be executed by the then record owners of a majority of the lots in said subdivision and duly recroded appointing a representative, or representatives, who whall hereafter exercise the same powers previously exercised by said committee.
- 3. No dwelling shall be permitted on any lot unless the ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one story open porches, carports, and garages, is not less than 800 square feet.
- W. No building shall be located on any lot nearer than 25 feet to the front lot line, or nearer than 8 feet with a total width of the 2 side yards of 18 feet, except that no side yard shall be required for a garage, carport, or other permitted accessory building located 70 feet or more from the front lot line. For the purposes of this covenant, eaves, steps, and open porches shall not be considered as a part of a building, provided, however, that this shall rot be construed to permit any portion of a building on a lot to encroach upon another lot.
- 5. No dwelling shall be erected or placed on any lot having a width of less than 60 feet at the minimum setback line nor shall any dwelling be erected or placed on any lot having an area of less than 6000 square feet.
- 6. Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat and over the rear five feet of each lot.

- 7. No noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood. The maximum heights on any fence shall be six feet and shall not extend beyond the front setback of the dwelling, provided however, that the building committee shall have the power to grant variances for retaining walls to extend beyond the front setback line.
- 8. No structure of a temporary character, trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn, or other outstanding shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence either temporarily or permanently.
- 9. These covents are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them for a period of twenty-five years from the date these covenants are recorded, after which time said covenants shall be autématically extended for successive periods of 10 years unless an instrument signed by the majority in whole or in part.
- 10. Enforcement shall be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any wovenant either to restrain violations or to recover damages.
- ll. Invalidation of any one of these wovenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
