This indenture made this 3/2day of May, 1951, by and between JAMES A. MILLER and MINERVA F. MILLER, his wife, Grantors, and THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF SALT LAKE CITY, Grantee.

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable considerations to the Grantors paid by the Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantors have bargained, sold, conveyed and by these presents do hereby convey unto the said Grantee an easement and right of way for a storm sewer over and through the following described real property, to-wit:

> Commencing at a point 5 rods West of the Southeast corner of Lot 3, Block 36, Plat "B", Salt Lake City Survey, and running thence West 15 rods to 3rd East Street, thence North $9\frac{1}{2}$ feet, thence East 15 rods to a point on the Grantor's East boundary $9\frac{1}{2}$ feet North of the place of beginning, thence South $9\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the place of beginning.

> Said storm sewer shall consist of an underground concrete pipe approximately 24" below the surface of the ground and shall have such surface openings in connection as shall be necessary for the accumulation of water and for cleanout purposes. The Grantee shall have the right to enter upon the premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of laying, maintaining, operating, repairing and removing said storm sewer.
