## The United States of America.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Bernard Snow junior, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South half of the North East quarter and the Lots numbered One and Two of Section Six in township Nine South of range Three East of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory containing One hundred and Sixty Acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Bernard Snow junior the tract of Land above described: To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Bernard Snow junior and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In Testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.


