

property of the Grantee herein, but this reversion shall not take effect in any event before seven (7) years from date hereof.

The Grantor also reserves the right to enter upon the above described property at reasonable times for the purpose of constructing and maintaining ditches or pipe lines along said rights-of-way and also for the purpose of re-drilling either or both of the wells above described; provided, however, that if either or both of said wells are re-drilled, they will be drilled within the easement hereinabove granted at some point within 4 feet of the North or South boundary, as the case may be.

The easement hereby granted for the conveyance of water in an open ditch is not an exclusive easement but the Grantee herein may use said open ditches for the purpose of conveying any waste water suitable for agricultural uses along and in said ditches. The Grantee may at its option bridge said ditches or enclose the same within pipe lines provided, however, that if the Grantee does so, it shall thereafter maintain such bridges or pipe lines so that the water of the Grantor may be conveyed from said wells to the West property line of the property hereinbefore described.
