## STATE OF UTAH PATENT NO. 20114

WHEREAS, The Nature Conservancy, a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation, 4245 N. Fairfax Dr., Arlington, VA 22203, registered to do business in Utah, 559 East South Temple, Salt Lake City UT 84102, heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State,

AND WHEREAS, The Nature Conservancy has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Four Hundred Forty Four Thousand Dollars and No Cent (\$444,000.00), and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of sale;

NOW THEREFORE I, JON M. HUNTSMAN, JR., Governor, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto The Nature Conservancy, a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation, and to its successors and assigns forever, the tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Washington, State of Utah, more particularly described in Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

TO HAVE AND TO BOLD the described and granted premises unto The Nature Conservancy, a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation, and to its successors and assigns forever,

Excepting and reserving to the State of Utah for the benefit of the State and its successor in interest, assigns, permittees, licenses and lessees from time to time, all coal, oil and gas and other mineral deposits, along with the right for the State or other authorized persons to prospect for, mine, and remove the deposits; also,

Excepting and reserving to the State of Utah, by and through the School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration, and its successors in interest, assigns, permittees, licensees and lessees in perpetuity, for the benefit of the general public, a trail easement generally depicted as "Hiking Trails" in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by reference (the "Trail Easement'), which Frail Easement shall be ten (10) feet in width, shall encompass a single track, natural surface trail, and shall be for pedestrian use only, and subject to the conditions in that certain Certificate of Sale No. 26466 regarding said trail; also,

Subject to a reversionary interest held by the State of Utah as follows: In the event the State of Utah, by and through the School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration or its successor agency, pursuant to the above described mineral reservation, shall exercise the right to permit its successors in interest, assigns, permittees, licensees or lessees to prospect for, mine or remove any mineral deposits in such a manner as to defeat the ecological purposes for which The
