Commencing on the West boundary of Grantors' land 150 feet north of a point 1380 feet East of the Southwest corner Sec. 27, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. L. M. - thence running South 89° 58' East 1238 feet to East boundary of Grantors' land; all contained within the South east 1/4 of Southwest 1/4, Section 27, said Township and Range. Together with full right of ingress and egress for all purposes of maintenance, inspection, repair, alteration and replacement of said circuits, supports and attachments.
