To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at

Salt Lake City, Utah,

has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862,

"To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of

**Charles A. Shay**

has been established and duly documented, in conformity to law, for the south half of Section six in Township seven south of Range five west of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing three hundred nineteen and sixty-hundredths acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES into the said claimant the tract of Land there described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the said claimant and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any record or reserved water rights for mining, agricultural, domestic, or other purposes, and to any other right or interest that may be lawfully reserved or hereafter reserved by any person or persons of court; and there is reserved from the said tract the amount of acreage reserved to the United States.
