TO  
PROTECTIVE COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR HILLSDALE SUBDIVISION NO. 7  
(Salt Lake County, Utah)

Protective Covenants and Restrictions for Hillsdale Subdivision No. 7, executed by Newell Knight Johnson, also known as Newell K. Johnson, and Dorothy R. Johnson, his wife, owners, on 17th day of March, 1960, and recorded in the office of the Salt Lake County Recorder on the 18th day of March, 1960, in Book 1695, at Pages 359 and 360, Reference No. 1706381, is hereby amended as follows:

The third line of paragraph A. is amended by deletion of:

"A. "or double family"

The first line of paragraph B. is amended so as to read:

"B. No building shall be erected, placed or altered on any residential building plot in this"

The fourth and fifth lines of paragraph I. are amended by deletion of:

"I. not less than 1000 square feet in the case of a one and one-half story, two-family structure"

New paragraph G. is added to read:

"G. Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat and over the rear five feet of each lot."

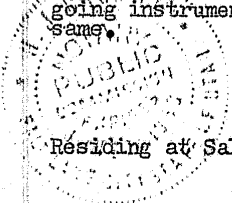
