Received of the AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF WYOMING Twenty-five 00/100 Dollars, in consideration of which we hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a perpetual right of way and easement to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over and/or under the property which we own or in which we have any interest in the Sec. 9 T. 2-N, R-5-E, County of Summit and State of Utah and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company and with the further right to cut down and keep cut down all trees, limbs of trees and undergrowth within 50 feet of said line. Said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted.

Grant herein is for one poleline only and consists of approximately nine (9) poles. Grantee agrees to furnish a definite description of the location of said line within a reasonable time after the final survey has been made.
