Ten00/100 Dollars, in consideration of which the DAVID MOORE AND SONS INCORPORATED, hereby grants and conveys unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a perpetual right of way and easement to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, gys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over/ and/or under the property which it owns or in which it has any interest in

the Section 4 of Township 4 North, Range 7 East and Sections 33 and 34 of Township 5 North, Range 7 East, County of SUMMIT and State of UTAH, and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company and with the further right to cut down and keep cut down all trees, limbs of trees and undergrowth with in 50 feet tof said line.
