Note: This plat is made to correct, as far as possible, the location of street lines in Central Park. The original plat dedicating said Addition was defective, inasmuch as it did not give ties to the city surveys and monuments—hence it is found necessary to make an official record of the proper location, ties to city surveys, monuments, etc., abandoning some lands heretofore used as part of streets through the erroneous original location, all as shown herein.

To Whom It May Concern:
The City Council of Ogden City, Utah, hereby declares as follows:

That the location and width of streets shown on the plat herewith shall be the true location and width of said streets and avenues (alleys not located). That the lands now occupied as streets outside of the lines hereby established are hereby abandoned for use as streets. That the location, width, measures etc., shown on the plat herewith, shall hereafter be the official locations, widths, measures and lines of said streets and avenues.
