

and rights to stretch and narrow, and connect, with each other—rights, as may be recognized and determined by the local Customs laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the rights of the proprietor of a City or town to erect and remove his dwelling house should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

### Patent No 26. The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, by the Act of Congress, approved July 1, 1862, July 2, 1864, July 3, 1866, joint resolution of July 26, 1866 and April 10, 1869, and the act of May 6, 1870 "to aid in the construction of a railroad and telegraph line from the Missouri River to the Pacific Ocean, and to secure to government the use of the same for postal, military and other purposes"; whereby is given to the Union Pacific Rail Road Company to construct, maintain and telegraph line, under certain conditions and stipulations, as contained in said acts; and provision is made for granting to the said company every alternate section of Public Land, designated by odd numbers to the amount of ten alternate sections per mile on each side of the said Rail road, one-half mile thereof, and within the limits of forty miles on each side of said road, first built, finished, or otherwise disposed of by the United States, and to which a Reservation in Homestead claim may not have attached, at the time the line of said road is definitely fixed.

And whereas an official statement bearing date November 11, 1869,

from the Secretary of the Interior has been filed in the General Land Office, showing that the Commissioners appointed by the President, under provisions of the last section of the said Act of Congress approved July 2, 1864, have reported to him that the line of railroad and telegraph from Omaha in the State of Nebraska, westward to Ogallala, in the Territory of Dakota, and known as the Union Pacific Rail Road, has been constructed and fully completed and equipped, in the manner prescribed by the acts of Congress, relative to the Pacific Railroad and Telegraph Line; and the Union Pacific Railway Company, formerly the Union Pacific Railroad Company, has applied for a Conveyance of the title to the lands granted to said Company by said acts of Congress of July 1, 1862 and July 2, 1864.

And whereas certain tracts have been selected, under the acts aforesaid, by Leavitt Burnham, the duly authorized land agent of the Union Pacific Railway Company formerly the Union Pacific Railroad Company as shown by his original list of selections dated May 24, 1881, certified under date of May 24, 1881, by the Register and Receiver at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory. - The said tracts of land lie contiguous to the constructed line of road, and are particularly described as follows, vizt:

North of baseline and West of Salt Lake Principal Meridian Creek, Hastings Township, One, Range One.

The North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section One, Containing forty acres, the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter, the West half of the South West Quarter and the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Three, Containing one hundred and sixty acres.

Crownsip Two, Range One

The North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section One, Containing forty acres. The North West Quarter of Section Thirteen, Containing one hundred and sixty acres. The West half of Section Twenty-one, Containing three hundred and twenty acres.

Crownsip Three, Range One

The North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-five, Containing forty acres.

Crownsip Three, Range One.

The North West Quarter of the South East Quarter, and the South West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen, Containing eighty acres, the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-three, Containing forty acres, the South East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Fourteen, Containing forty acres, the South West Quarter of Section Thirty-five, Containing one hundred and sixty acres.

## Township six, Range one.

The South West Quarter of the North West Quarter, the South half of the South West Quarter, and the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section fifteen, containing three hundred and sixty acres, The East half of the South West Quarter, the East half of the South East Quarter and the West half of the South East Quarter of Section twenty seven, containing two hundred and forty acres.

## Township Four, Range Two.

The South half of Section seventeen, containing three hundred and twenty acres.

## Township Five, Range Two.

The North half of the North East Quarter, and the West half of Section one, containing four hundred acres and fifteen one hundredths of an acre. The East half of the South East Quarter of Section three containing eighty acres. The South half of the South East Quarter of Section fifteen, one, containing eighty acres. The South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section thirty one, containing forty acres, The South East Quarter of Section thirty five, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

## Township Six, Range Two.

The South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section twenty five, containing forty acres. The South West Quarter of Section thirty five, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

North of two line and East of Salt Lake Principal Meridian, Utah Territory.

## Township Three, Range One.

The South half of the North East Quarter of Section thirty one, containing eighty acres.

## Township Six, Range One.

The North West Quarter of Section one, containing one hundred and fifty one acres and twenty five one hundredths of an acre, The East half of the North East Quarter of Section three, containing eighty acres. The South half of the South West Quarter, the South half of the South East Quarter and the South half of Section eleven, containing five hundred and twenty acres. The South half of the North East Quarter and the West half of Section thirteen, containing four hundred and eighty acres, the East half of the North East Quarter and the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section fifteen, containing one hundred and twenty acres, all of Section twenty three containing one hundred and forty acres.

## Township Seven, Range One.

The North West Quarter of the North East Quarter, the North East

quarter of the North West Quarter, the South West quarter and the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section twenty one Containing two hundred and eighty acres, The North West Quarter, the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter, and the South East Quarter of Section twenty one Containing three hundred and sixty acres, The South East Quarter of Section twenty seven, Containing One hundred and sixty acres. The East half of the North West Quarter, the East half of the South West Quarter and the East half of Section twenty nine, Containing four hundred and eighty acres, The North East Quarter of Section thirty three, Containing One hundred and sixty acres. The North East Quarter, and the West half of Section thirty five, Containing four hundred and eighty acres.

#### Township Five Range Two

The West half of the North West Quarter of Section twenty nine, Containing eighty acres, The South half of the South West Quarter (or the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter) and the lot numbered four of Section thirty one, Containing eighty acres and One hundredths of an acre.

#### Township Six Range Two

The North half of the North East Quarter, the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter, the North West Quarter, the South half of the South West Quarter, the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter and the South half of the South East Quarter of Section seven, Containing four hundred and seventy five acres and forty seven One hundredths of an acre. The South half of the South West Quarter, and the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section nine, Containing one hundred and twenty acres, The South half of the South West Quarter and the North half of the North West Quarter of Section fifteen, Containing One hundred and sixty acres. The South East Quarter and the West half of Section seventeen, Containing four hundred and eighty acres. All of Section nineteen, Containing six hundred and thirty five acres and forty four One hundredths of an acre.

#### Township Seven Range Two

The West half of the South West Quarter, and the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section thirty one Containing One hundred and One hundredths of an acre.

#### Township Four Range Three

The lot numbered two of the North West Quarter, the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter, and the lot numbered three of the South West Quarter of Section thirty one Containing One hundred and forty acres.

#### Township One Range Five

The North East Quarter of the North East Quarter, and the South half of the South West Quarter of section nine, containing one hundred and twenty acres, The South half of North East Quarter, and the South East Quarter of Section seventeen, containing two hundred and forty acres. The South West Quarter of the South East Quarter and the South half of the South West Quarter of section twenty-five containing one hundred and twenty acres, The South half of the South West Quarter, and the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of section thirty-one containing one hundred and forty acres. And six one hundredths of an acre, The West half of the North West Quarter of section thirty-three, containing eighty acres.

#### Township Two. Range Five.

The South West Quarter of the North East Quarter, the South half of the North West Quarter, and the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of section eleven, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

The South West Quarter and the West half of the South East Quarter of section twenty-one, containing two hundred and forty acres.

The North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of section twenty-five containing forty acres. The North West Quarter of the North East Quarter, and the East half of the North West Quarter of section thirty-three containing one hundred and twenty acres.

#### Township Two. Range Six.

The West half of the South East Quarter of section five containing eighty acres.

\* South of baseline and East of Salt Lake bounded Canadian State Territory.

#### Township One. Range Three.

The North West Quarter of the North East Quarter and the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of section thirteen containing eighty acres.

#### Township One. Range Four.

The East half of the South East Quarter of section seven containing eighty acres. The North East Quarter of section twenty-five containing one hundred and sixty acres.

#### Township One. Range Five.

The North half of the North East Quarter, and the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of section fifteen containing one hundred and forty acres, The South half of the South East Quarter and the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of section twenty-five containing one hundred and forty acres.

Township One Range Six

The South East quarter of Section nineteen containing one hundred and fifty acres, the North West quarter of Section thirty one, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and eighty eight one hundredths of an acre.

The said tracts of land as described in the foregoing make the aggregate area of (11.250.93) eleven thousand two hundred and thirty acres and twenty three one hundredths of an acre.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and pursuant to the said Acts of Congress have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Union Pacific Railway Company formerly the Union Pacific Railroad Company, and to its assigns the tracts of land selected as aforesaid and described in the foregoing; yet excluding and excepting from the transfer by these presents "All Mineral lands should any such be found to exist on the tracts described in the foregoing, but this exclusion and exception of according to the terms of the Statute shall not be construed to include Coal and iron land".

To have and to hold the said tracts, with the appurtenances, unto the said "Union Pacific Railway Company" and to its assigns forever, with the exclusion and exception as aforesaid.
