The right to use of the waters of Center Creek as awarded in Civil Decree No. 55, in the Fourth Judicial District Court of the State of Utah, in and for the County of Wasatch; the Center Creek Water and Irrigation Company, a corporation, Plaintiff, vs. John A. Thomas, Defendant, dated June 15, 1898, Judge Warren N. Dusenberry, presiding. Also,

A diligence right to store 581.2 acre-feet of water in the Center Creek Reservoirs No. 1, 2, 3, and 5, as described in Claim No. 923 (55-1440) on file in the State Engineer's office of the State of Utah.

The officers who sign this deed hereby certify that this deed and the transfer represented thereby was duly authorized under a resolution adopted by its stockholders at a lawful meeting duly held and attended.
