NINETEENTH AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION FOR THE COLONY AT WHITE PINE CANYON

The Members holding in excess of Sixty Percent (60%) of the total votes of the Association, hereby amend the By-Laws of the Homeowner's Association for The colony at White Pine Canyon recorded September 28, 1998, as Entry No. 518625, in Book 1286, at Pages 47-58 (the "By-Laws"), as previously amended by the First Amendment to said By-Laws recorded September 15, 1999, as Entry No. 548587, in Book 1287, at Rages 731-733, the Second Amendment to said By-Laws recorded December 29, 2000, as Entry No. 579436, in Book 1347, at Pages 712-714, the Third Amendment to said By-Laws recorded December 28, 2001, as Entry No. 607118, in Book 1424, at Pages 860-863, the Fourth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded June 25, 2002, as Entry No. 623052, in Book 1456, at Page 1204, the Fifth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded April 11, 2003, as Entry No. 654514, in Book 1525, at Page 1804 the Sixth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded June 25, 2003, as Entry No. 663161, in Book 1545, at Page 1208, the Seventh Amendment to said By-Laws recorded January 26, 2004, as Entry No. 687137, in Book 1595, at Page 1638, the Eighth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded March 1, 2006, as Entry No. 770216, in Book 1774, at Page 856, the Ninth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded August 24, 2006, as Entry No. 788382, in Book 1812, at Rage 704, the Tenth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded September 21, 2007, as Entry No. 826012, in Book 1890, at Page 298, the Eleventh Amendment to said By-Laws recorded March 15, 2010, as Entry No. 894025, in Book 2024, at Page 662, the Twelfth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded June 14, 2011, as Entry No. 924376 Book 2084, at Page 540, the Thirteenth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded June 22, 2011, as Entry No. 925149, in Book 2085, at Page 981, the Fourteenth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded April 13, 2012, as Entry No. 943177, in 800k 2123, at Page 1789, the Fifteenth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded October 17, 2012, as Entry No. 00955351, in Book 2151, at Page 1822, the Sixteenth Amendment to said By-Laws recorded October 17, 2012, as Entry No. 00955363, in Book 2151, at Page 1946, the Seventeenth Amendment to said By-laws recorded September 18, 2013, as Entry 00979410, in Book 2207, at Page 0822, the Eighteenth Amendment to said By-laws recorded April 11, 2014, as Entry 00993150, in Book 2235, at Page 0650, and this Nineteenth Amendment to said By-Laws to be recorded upon adoption (collectively the "By-Laws").

- 1. Article 2 Board of Trustees is hereby amended to add Section 2.11 which shall hereafter read as follows:
 - 2.11 <u>Electronic Participation at Meetings</u>. Trustees may participate in and act any meeting, including General and Special Meetings, of the Board of Trustees

through the use of conference telephone, video conference, or other communications equipment, so long as the equipment is reasonably available and so long as all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with each other concurrently. A Trustee participating via electronic communication equipment will constitute a Trustee in attendance and present at the meeting.

- Article 2. <u>Board of Trustees</u> is hereby further amended to add Section 2.12, which shall hereafter read as follows:
 - 2.12 <u>Ballots and Email Voting</u>. Trustees who are unable to attend a meeting of the Board of Trustees, including General and Special Meetings, either in person or by electronic participation, may vote via electronic mail (Email) on specific issues identified in the notice of meeting so long as the notice of meeting includes a separate ballot specifically identifying the issues which may be voted on via Email and subject to the following:
 - a. Trustees submitting votes via Email shall be counted as attending the meeting for purposes of establishing a quorum on the issues noticed and presented for vote on the ballot.
 - Issues that arise during a given meeting which are not specifically identified in the notice of meeting and accompanying ballot, may not be voted on by absent Trustees via Email at that meeting and shall instead require a notice of any new or rescheduled meeting and opportunity to either attend in person or vote by Email pursuant to a new ballot.
 - c. Votes east via Email must be received by the representative of the Association designated in the notice and ballot to receive emails prior to the commencement time of the meeting. Email votes received after the commencement time of the meeting shall not be counted.
 - d. The ballot shall provide the appropriate Email address for Trustees to use for purposes of voting, in the event no email address is provided then email voting shall not be allowed for that given meeting. A vote submitted by Email to an address other than the specific one provided in the notice of meeting shall not be counted and shall otherwise be considered void.
- 3. Article 3. <u>Meetings of the Members of the Association</u> and more specifically, Section 3.1, is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as follows:
 - 3.1 Quorum and Voting. The presence in person, by proxy, or by Email (as provided for below) at any meeting of the Members of the Association, duly called and noticed, representing a majority of the total of all votes vested in Members, shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. If however, such quorum shall not

be present or represented at any meeting, the Board of Trustees shall have power to adjourn the meeting and reschedule for a time not earlier than twenty-four (24) hours, nor later than fifteen (15) days after the set time for the original meeting. No notice of such rescheduled meeting shall be required except an oral announcement at the meeting to be rescheduled and Email notice to those who have timely submitted votes via Email. The presence of Members and holders of proxies entitled to cast more than thirty-five percent (35%) of the total of all votes vested in Members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at the rescheduled meeting. Unless otherwise provided in the Declaration, Bylaws, or Articles, any action may be taken at any meeting of the Members of the Association where a quorum is present, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of votes of the Members present.

- a. <u>Electronic Participation at Meetings</u>. Members may participate in and act at any meeting, including General and Special Meetings, of the members through the use of conference telephone, video conference, or other communications equipment, so long as the equipment reasonably available and so long as all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with each other concurrently. A Member participating via electronic communication equipment will constitute a Member in attendance and present at the meeting.
- Ballots and Email Voting. Members who are unable to attend a meeting of the members, including General and Special Meetings, either in person or by electronic participation, may vote via electronic mail (Email) on specific issues identified in the notice of meeting so long as the notice of meeting includes a separate ballot specifically identifying the issues which may be voted on via Email and subject to the following:
 - Members submitting votes via Email shall be counted as attending the meeting for purposes of establishing a quorum on the ssues noticed and presented for vote on the ballot.
 - ii. Issues that arise during a given meeting which are not specifically identified in the notice of meeting and accompanying ballot, may not be voted on by absent Member via Email at that meeting and shall instead require a notice of any new or rescheduled meeting and opportunity to either attend in person or vote by Email pursuant to a new ballot.

iii. Votes cast via Email must be received by the representative of the Association designated in the notice and ballot to receive emails prior to the commencement time of the meeting. Email votes received after the commencement time of the meeting shall not be counted.

The ballot shall provide the appropriate Email address for Members to use for purposes of voting, in the event no Email address is provided then Email voting shall not be allowed for that given meeting. A vote submitted by Email to an address other than the specific one provided in the notice of meeting shall not be counted and shall otherwise be considered void.

Except as modified by this Nineteenth Amendment, the By-Laws as originally recorded and as previously amended, remain in full force and effect.

Section 15 of the Bylaws provides that the Bylaws can be amended upon the written approval of Association Members holding at least sixty-percent (60%) of the total votes of the Association.

This Nineteenth Amendment shall be binding against the property as described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
