## ORDINANCE NO. 98-3

AN ORDINANCE NARROWING A PORTION OF CHERRY STREET, A PUBLIC STREET LOCATED IN GRANTSVILLE CITY, UTAH.

Be it enacted and ordained by the City Council of Grantsville City, Utah as follows:

SECTION ONE: PURPOSE. This Ordinance is for the purpose of narrowing a portion of Cherry Street by vacating and abandoning the northerly 30 feet of Cherry Street located between Hale and West Streets. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to a petition of a property owners whose property abuts Cherry Street. The Grantsville City Council after conducting a public hearing finds that there is good cause to narrow this City street and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest.

**SECTION TWO: NARROWING A PORTION OF CHERRY STREET.** Cherry Street is hereby narrowed by the formal vacation of the north or northerly most 30 feet of said street located between Hale and West Streets in Grantsville City, Tooele County, Utah, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10-8-8.1 through 10-8-8.5 of the Utah Code.

**SECTION TWO: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect upon the posting of three complete copies of this ordinance in three public places within Grantsville City, Utah as provided for by law.
