PERIOD AND NATURE OF USE

FROM JANUARY 1 TO DECEMBER 31 INCLUSIVE OF EACH YEAR FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES AND PURPOSES INCIDENT THEREIN

Whereas, It has been made to appear to the satisfaction of the undersigned that the appropriation of water has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Utah; therefore, Be it known that I ED. H. WATSON the duly appointed, qualified and acting State Engineer, by authority

of the Laws of Utah, do hereby certify that said appropriator is entitled to the use of water as herein set out, subject to prior rights, if any, for diversion and use as follows, to wit:

The water appropriated is yielded by a flowing well fully cased with 2-in. galvanized iron pipe, driven to a depth of 252 ft. below ground surface, situated N 1253.01 ft. and W 681.30 ft. from S $\frac{1}{2}$ Cor. Sec. 30 T15S R1E S18E $\frac{1}{2}$. From the well the water is conveyed North 40 ft. through 1-in. galvanized iron pipe to an electrically driven pump and pressure tank, located in the basement of a house. The water appropriated is, from the pressure tank, distributed within said house through 125 ft. of 1/2-in. pipe, where it is, during the entire year, intermittently released and used for domestic purposes in serving one family. The water appropriated is, from an outlet on the well and a house foundation outlet, during the period from April 1 to October 31 of each year, intermittently released and used through garden hose to irrigate 1200 sq. ft. of lawn and garden surrounding the dwelling. The water appropriated is, from the pump, conveyed North 60 ft. through 1/2-in. pipe to an outlet in a corral where it is, during the entire year, intermittently released and used in a tub to water 1 cow and 200 chickens.

The amount of water appropriated for incidental irrigation or stock watering is limited to an amount less than that appropriated for domestic (household) purposes.

The diverting and distributing works are to be operated and maintained in such manner and condition as will prevent waste of water.
