NOTICE OF FEDERAL INTEREST

On March 4, 2010, the National Center for Research Resources awarded Grant Number 1C06RR022056-01 to the University of Utah. The award provides Federal funds for construction of a building addition which is located on the land described below Salt Lake County, State of Utah,

These award conditions and requirements cannot be nullified or voided through a change in usage or transfer of ownership. Therefore, advance notice of any proposed change in usage or ownership must be given to the National Center for Research Resources Grants Management Officer, who must approve such a change.
