SNOW FENCE EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, ELMER N. JENSEN and LOIS JENSEN, his wife, of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give and grant unto KENNECOTT COPPER CORPORATION, a corporation of the State of New York duly qualified to do business in the State of Utah, and to its successors and assigns, an easement and right to erect, construct and perpetually maintain a snow fence or snow fences over, across and upon the following described tract of land situate in the NE 1/4 of Section 27, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., S. L. B. & M., Salt Lake County, State of Utah, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the North boundary line of said Section 27, said point being West 426.0 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 27, and running thence S. 33° 01' W., 900.0 feet; thence N. 56° 59' W., 130.0 feet to a point in the Easterly side line of a right of way described in that certain Right of Way Deed heretofore granted by Conrad S. Dahl and Reta C. 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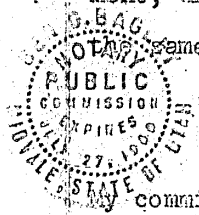
