NOW, THEREFORE, the Association, by and through its Board, hereby amends the Declaration as follows:

Declaration Article IV, Section 1 is amended to reflect that the annual meeting of the Members may take place on a date and at a time and place set by the Board, so long as said date occurs within the first quarter of the year, and therefore, the following language shall replace the first sentence of said Section:

The annual meeting of the Members shall be held during the first quarter of each year, at a date, time, and place deemed appropriate and convenient by the Trustees.
