the following described tract^s of land in Salt Lake - - - - - County,

State of Utah, to-wit: lots No. 12 and 13, Burnt Flat Subdivision in Big Cottonwood Canyon, including land to the center of abutting roads, all subject to conditions set forth in the official plat of said subdivision on file in the office of the County Recorder of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, in Book "L" of Plats at Page 7 thereof, reserving to grantors, their heirs and assigns, and the public, a perpetual right-of-way over roads abutting said Lots 12 and 13, and granting to Grantee, his heirs and assigns, and the public, a right-of-way over all existing roads in said subdivision;

subject to taxes for the year 1951 and subsequent years and to all established rights-of-way and easements over said land, and to sanitary and other regulations prescribed or to be prescribed and court decisions rendered or to be rendered by the United States Government, the State of Utah, Salt Lake County, Salt Lake City, and all other governmental agencies in reference to the ownership, use and protection of the forest reserves, water and watershed in Big Cottonwood Canyon, which regulations and decisions, Grantee for himself, his heirs, personal representatives and assigns hereby agrees to observe and abide by.
