THE DECLARANT made this 31st day of October, 1950, by this Declaration, a corporation, hereinafter called the "Declarant".

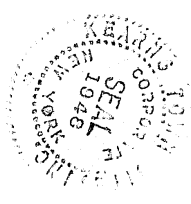
