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THIS AGREEMENT FOR EASEMENT (NON-EXCLUSIVE) is made and entered into as of this 16th day of October, 1996 ("Agreement"), by and between Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation ("Grantor"), and West Bountiful City, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah ("Grantee");

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Grantee desires to obtain from Grantor and Grantor is willing to grant and convey to Grantee a non-exclusive, perpetual underground storm drain pipeline easement according to the terms and conditions herein set forth:

- 1. Grantor shall grant and convey to Grantee a non-exclusive perpetual underground easement and right-of-way, together with the right of reasonable ingress and egress to construct, own, operate, maintain, repair and replace an underground storm drain pipeline and appurtenant improvements on, over, across, under and through Grantor's land located in Davis County, State of Utah, pursuant to a formal Grant of Easement document, the form of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference. The easement area is legally described in Exhibit "A" ("Premises") and shown on the attached Exhibit "B" which is incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. As consideration for the grant of easement, the Grantee shall pay to the Grantor the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).
- 3. The easement granted herein is non-exclusive and may be used by Grantor or any others, taking by, through or under Grantor, and Grantor's invitees.

- 4. Grantee shall not erect or install any barrier that may interfere with the ingress or egress of vehicular or pedestrian traffic to or from Grantor's property.
- 5. Grantee shall not unreasonably interfere with Grantor's use of the Premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor intends to continue to maintain a Chevron advertising sign pole and planter boxes ("Improvements") within the Premises. Grantee shall not interfere with the Improvements and shall insure that the Improvements are fully supported and undamaged during its use of the Premises. Grantor retains the right to make use of the Premises including, but not limited to, maintenance of Improvements, relocation of Improvements and other activities associated with its business on the property adjacent to the Premises.
- 6. Grantee shall, upon the completion of any work within the Premises, return the Premises to a condition that is as good or better than it was in prior to Grantee's work.
- 7. Grantor's use of the Premises shall not unreasonably interfere with Grantee's use of the Premises as provided in this Agreement. The primary use of the Premises is to support Grantor's business on the property adjacent to the Premises.
- 8. Grantee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Grantor, insofar as it is legally able to do so, from any liability arising out of Grantee's activities or operations under this Agreement. Grantee further agrees to assume responsibility for any damages proximately caused by reason of Grantee's activities or operations under this Agreement and Grantee shall, at its option, either repair or pay for any such damage.
- 9. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of Grantor and Grantee and their respective successors, assigns and contractors, as the case may be.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes all 10. prior agreements, either written or oral, regarding which is the subject matter of this Agreement.
