THE PRESBYTERY OF SALT LAKE, a Utah corporation, Grantor,
hereby quit-claims to the JAPANESE CHURCH OF CHRIST, of Salt Lake City,
a Utah corporation, Grantee, for the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, the
following described tracts of land situate in Salt Lake City, Salt Lake
County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Tract (a) Commencing at a point 70 feet East of
the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Block 78,
Plat "A", Salt Lake City Survey, and run-
ning thence North 165 feet; thence East
75 feet; thence South 165 feet; thence
West 75 feet to the point of beginning.

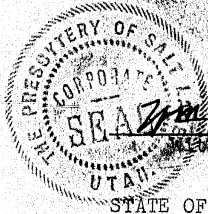
Also Tract (b) Commencing at the Northeast corner of
Lot 5, in Block 67, Plat "A", Salt Lake
City Survey, and running thence West
64 feet; thence South 165 feet; thence
East 64 feet; thence North 165 feet to
the point of beginning.

said tracts of land and all rights, privileges and appurten-
ances used in connection therewith.

encumbrances upon said tracts of land and either thereof.

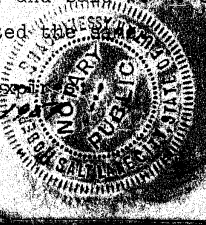
