OILSON BROTHERS COMPANY, a corporation, doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and two pole towers, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at south boundary line of grantor's land at a point 680 feet east, more or less, from the west quarter corner of Section 3, T.3 S., R.2 W., S.L.B.& M., thence N.7°33'E. 5320 feet, more or less, to north boundary line of said land and being in the W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 3 and the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4, the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 34, T.2 S., R.2 W., S.L.B.& M.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
