Mitchell, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter, and the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of and the Lot Numbered Two, and the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter of and the Lot Numbered Two, and the South of Range Six East, of Salt Lake Meridian, Section Eighteen, in Township Two South of Range Six East, of Salt Lake Meridian, in Utah, containing the hundred and sixty acres and sixty six hundredths of an acre. NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Jerome K. Mitchell, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of courts,, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
