ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES AND RENTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES AND RENTS (this “**Assignment**”) is made as of this 7th day of November, 2024, by **2100 AND 2100, LLC**, a Utah limited liability company, as assignor, having its principal place of business at 4655 South 2300 East, Suite 205, Holladay, UT 84117 (“**Borrower**”), to and for the benefit of **DPI-ACRES CAPITAL LLC**, a Delaware limited liability company, as Administrative Agent, having an address c/o ACRES Capital Servicing, LLC, 390 RXR Plaza, Uniondale, New York 11556, and its successors and assigns (in such capacity, “**Administrative Agent**”), as assignee.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, this Assignment is given in connection with a loan (the “**Loan**”) in the principal sum of Thirty-Two Million and No/100 Dollars (\$32,000,000.00) advanced pursuant to that certain Loan Agreement, dated as of the date hereof, by and among Borrower, Administrative Agent and each of the lenders (together with its successors and assigns, individually and collectively, as the context may require, “**Lender**”) from time to time a party to thereto (as the same may hereafter be amended, restated, replaced, supplemented, renewed, extended or otherwise modified from time to time, the “**Loan Agreement**”), and evidenced by, among other things, that certain (i) Promissory Note A-1 in the maximum principal sum of Sixteen Million and No/100 Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) dated as of even date herewith made payable to the order of DPI-ACRES Capital LLC, as Lender (“**Note A-1**”), and (ii) Promissory Note A-2 in the maximum principal sum of Sixteen Million and No/100 Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) dated as of even date herewith made payable to the order of DPI-ACRES Capital LLC, as Lender (“**Note A-2**”, together with Note A-1 and with all extensions, renewals, modifications, substitutions and amendments thereof shall collectively be referred to as the “**Note**”);

WHEREAS, Borrower desires to secure the payment of the Debt (as defined in the Loan Agreement) and the performance of all of its obligations under the Note, the Loan Agreement and the other Loan Documents; and

WHEREAS, this Assignment is given pursuant to the Loan Agreement, and payment, fulfillment, and performance by Borrower of its obligations thereunder and under the other Loan Documents is secured hereby, and each and every term and provision of the Loan Agreement and the Note, including the rights, remedies, obligations, covenants, conditions, agreements, indemnities, representations and warranties therein, are hereby incorporated by reference herein as though set forth in full and shall be considered a part of this Assignment.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the making of the Loan by Lender and the covenants, agreements, representations and warranties set forth in this Assignment, the undersigned, intending to be legally bound, hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

ARTICLE 1 - ASSIGNMENT

Section 1.1 Property Assigned. Borrower hereby absolutely and unconditionally assigns, transfers and grants to Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender, as security for the Loan, the following property, rights, interests and estates, now owned, or hereafter acquired by Borrower:

(a) Leases. All leases, subleases or subsubleases, lettings, licenses, concessions or other agreements made a part thereof (whether written or oral and whether now or hereafter in effect), pursuant to which any Person is granted a possessory interest in, or a right to use or occupy, all or any portion of any space in that certain lot or piece of land, more particularly described in Exhibit A annexed hereto and made a part hereof, together with the buildings, structures, fixtures, additions, enlargements, extensions, modifications, repairs, replacements and improvements now or hereafter located thereon (collectively, the “**Property**”) and every modification, amendment or other agreement relating to such leases, subleases, subsubleases, or other agreements entered into in connection with such leases, subleases, subsubleases, or other agreements and every guarantee of the performance and observance of the covenants, conditions and agreements to be performed and observed by the other party thereto, and the right, title and interest of Borrower, its successors and assigns, therein and thereunder.

(b) Other Leases and Agreements. All other leases and other agreements, whether or not in writing, affecting the use, enjoyment or occupancy of the Property or any portion thereof now or hereafter made, whether made before or after the filing by or against Borrower of any petition for relief under 11 U.S.C. §101 et seq., as the same may be amended from time to time (the “**Bankruptcy Code**”) together with any extension, renewal or replacement of the same. This Assignment of other present and future leases and present and future agreements shall be effective without further or supplemental assignment. The “leases” described in Subsection 1.1(a) and the leases and other agreements described in this Subsection 1.1(b) are collectively referred to as the “**Leases**”.

(c) Rents. All rents, rent equivalents, income, receivables, revenues, receipts, insurance proceeds, deposits and profits arising from the Leases and renewals thereof together with all rents, rent equivalents, income, fees, receivables, accounts, profits (including, but not limited to, all oil and gas or other mineral royalties and bonuses), charges for services rendered and any and all payment and consideration of whatever form or nature received by Borrower or its agents or employees from any and all sources relating to the use, enjoyment and occupancy of the Property whether paid or accruing before or after the filing by or against Borrower of any petition for relief under the Bankruptcy Code (collectively, the “**Rents**”).

(d) Security Deposits. Any and all security deposits, in whatever form paid or given by, or on behalf of, any lessee of any Lease to Borrower (the “**Security Deposits**”).

(e) Bankruptcy Claims. All of Borrower’s claims and rights (the “**Bankruptcy Claims**”) to the payment of damages arising from any rejection by a lessee of any Lease under the Bankruptcy Code.

(f) Lease Guaranties. All of Borrower's right, title and interest in and claims under any and all lease guaranties, letters of credit and any other credit support (individually, a "Lease Guaranty", collectively, the "Lease Guaranties") given by any guarantor in connection with any of the Leases or leasing commissions (individually, a "Lease Guarantor", collectively, the "Lease Guarantors") to Borrower.

(g) Proceeds. All proceeds from the sale or other disposition of the Leases, the Rents, the Security Deposits, the Lease Guaranties and the Bankruptcy Claims.

(h) Other. All rights, powers, privileges, options and other benefits of Borrower as lessor under the Leases and Security Deposits and beneficiary under the Lease Guaranties, including without limitation the immediate and continuing right to make claim for, receive and collect all Rents payable or receivable under the Leases and all sums payable under the Lease Guaranties or pursuant thereto (and to apply the same to the payment of the Debt or the Other Obligations), and to do all other things which Borrower or any lessor is or may become entitled to do under the Leases, the Security Deposits or the Lease Guaranties.

(i) Entry. The right, at Administrative Agent's option, upon revocation of the license granted herein, to enter upon the Property in person, by agent or by court-appointed receiver, to collect the Rents.

(j) Power of Attorney. Borrower's irrevocable power of attorney, coupled with an interest, to take any and all of the actions set forth in Section 3.1 of this Assignment and any or all other actions designated by Administrative Agent for the proper management and preservation of the Property.

(k) Other Rights and Agreements. Any and all other rights of Borrower in and to the items set forth in subsections (a) through (k) above, and all amendments, modifications, replacements, renewals and substitutions thereof.

ARTICLE 2 - TERMS OF ASSIGNMENT

Section 2.1 Present Assignment and License Back. It is intended by Borrower that this Assignment constitute a present, absolute assignment and transfer of the Leases, Rents, Security Deposits, Lease Guaranties and Bankruptcy Claims, and not an assignment for additional security only. Nevertheless, subject to the terms of this Section 2.1 and the terms of the Loan Agreement and the other Loan Documents, Lender grants to Borrower a revocable license (which is revocable upon the occurrence of an Event of Default) to (i) collect, receive, use and enjoy the Rents, Security Deposits and other sums due under the Lease Guaranties and Borrower shall hold such Rents, Security Deposits and all sums received pursuant to any Lease Guaranty, or a portion thereof sufficient to discharge all current sums due on the Debt, in trust for the benefit of Lender for use in the payment of such sums and (ii) enforce the terms of the Leases and the Lease Guaranties.

Section 2.2 Notice To Lessees. Borrower hereby authorizes and directs the lessees named in the Leases or any other future lessees or occupants of the Property and all Lease Guarantors to pay over to Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender or to such other

party as Administrative Agent directs all Rents and all sums due under any Lease Guaranties upon receipt from Administrative Agent of written notice to the effect that Administrative Agent is then the holder of this Assignment and that an Event of Default (as defined in the Loan Agreement) exists, and to continue so to do until otherwise notified by Administrative Agent. Borrower will do nothing to impede, obstruct, hinder or delay Lender's exercise of its rights to receive such payments directly from the lessee under each Lease.

Section 2.3 Incorporation By Reference. All representations, warranties, covenants, conditions and agreements contained in the Loan Agreement and the other Loan Documents as same may be modified, renewed, substituted or extended are hereby made a part of this Assignment to the same extent and with the same force as if fully set forth herein.

ARTICLE 3 - REMEDIES

Section 3.1 Remedies of Lender. Upon or at any time after the occurrence of an Event of Default, the license granted to Borrower in Section 2.1 of this Assignment shall automatically be revoked, and Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender shall thereupon immediately be entitled to possession of all Rents and sums due under any Lease Guaranties, whether or not Administrative Agent enters upon or takes control of the Property. In addition, Administrative Agent may, at its option, without waiving such Event of Default, without regard to the adequacy of the security for the Debt, either in person or by agent, nominee or attorney, with or without bringing any action or proceeding, or by a receiver appointed by a court, dispossess Borrower and its agents, employees and servants from the Property, without liability for trespass, damages or otherwise and exclude Borrower and its agents, employees and servants wholly therefrom, and take possession of the Property and all books, records and accounts relating thereto and have, hold, manage, lease and operate the Property on such terms and for such period of time as Administrative Agent may deem proper and either with or without taking possession of the Property in its own name, demand, sue for or otherwise collect and receive all Rents and sums due under all Lease Guaranties, including those past due and unpaid with full power to make from time to time all alterations, renovations, repairs or replacements thereto or thereof as Administrative Agent may deem proper and may apply the Rents and sums received pursuant to any Lease Guaranties to the payment of the following in such order and proportion as Administrative Agent in its sole discretion may determine, any law, custom or use to the contrary notwithstanding: (a) all expenses of managing and securing the Property, including, without being limited thereto, the salaries, fees and wages of a managing agent and such other employees or agents as Administrative Agent may deem necessary or desirable and all expenses of operating and maintaining the Property, including, without being limited thereto, all taxes, charges, claims, assessments, water charges, sewer rents and any other liens, and premiums for all insurance which Administrative Agent may deem necessary or desirable, and the cost of all alterations, renovations, repairs or replacements, and all expenses incident to taking and retaining possession of the Property; and (b) the Debt, together with all costs and reasonable attorneys' fees. In addition, upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, Administrative Agent, at its option, may (i) complete any construction on the Property in such manner and form as Administrative Agent deems advisable, (ii) exercise all rights and powers of Borrower, including, without limitation, the right to negotiate, execute, cancel, enforce or modify any Leases, obtain and evict tenants, and demand, sue for, collect and receive all Rents from the

Property and all sums due under any Lease Guaranties, (iii) require Borrower to pay monthly in advance to Administrative Agent, or any receiver appointed to collect the Rents, the fair and reasonable rental value for the use and occupancy of such part of the Property as may be in possession of Borrower or (iv) require Borrower to vacate and surrender possession of the Property to Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender or to such receiver and, in default thereof, Borrower may be evicted by summary proceedings or otherwise. In the event Borrower cures any Event of Default (provided that Administrative Agent has not otherwise accelerated the Loan, moved for a receiver or commenced foreclosure proceedings), the license granted to Borrower in Section 2.1 hereof shall be automatically reinstated.

Section 3.2 Other Remedies. Nothing contained in this Assignment and no act done or omitted by Administrative Agent pursuant to the power and rights granted to Administrative Agent hereunder shall be deemed to be a waiver by Lender or Administrative Agent of their respective rights and remedies under the Loan Agreement, the Note, or the other Loan Documents and this Assignment is made and accepted without prejudice to any of the rights and remedies possessed by Administrative Agent under the terms thereof. The right of Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender to collect the Debt and to enforce any other security therefor held by it may be exercised by Administrative Agent either prior to, simultaneously with, or subsequent to any action taken by it hereunder. Borrower hereby absolutely, unconditionally and irrevocably waives any and all rights to assert any setoff, counterclaim or crossclaim of any nature whatsoever with respect to the obligations of Borrower under this Assignment, the Loan Agreement, the Note, the other Loan Documents or otherwise with respect to the Loan in any action or proceeding brought by Administrative Agent or Lender to collect same, or any portion thereof, or to enforce and realize upon the lien and security interest created by this Assignment, the Loan Agreement, the Note, or any of the other Loan Documents (provided, however, that the foregoing shall not be deemed a waiver of Borrower's right to assert any compulsory counterclaim if such counterclaim is compelled under local law or rule of procedure, nor shall the foregoing be deemed a waiver of Borrower's right to assert any claim which would constitute a defense, setoff, counterclaim or crossclaim of any nature whatsoever against Administrative Agent or Lender in any separate action or proceeding).

Section 3.3 Other Security. Lender may take or release other security for the payment and performance of the Debt, may release any party primarily or secondarily liable therefor and may apply any other security held by it to the payment and performance of the Debt, in each instance, without prejudice to any of its rights under this Assignment.

Section 3.4 Non-Waiver. The exercise by Administrative Agent of the option granted it in Section 3.1 of this Assignment and the collection of the Rents and sums due under the Lease Guaranties and the application thereof as herein provided shall not be considered a waiver of any Default or Event of Default by Borrower under the Note, the Loan Agreement, the Leases, this Assignment or the other Loan Documents. The failure of Administrative Agent to insist upon strict performance of any term hereof shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any term of this Assignment. Borrower shall not be relieved of Borrower's obligations hereunder by reason of (a) the failure of Lender or Administrative Agent to comply with any request of Borrower or any other party to take any action to enforce any of the provisions hereof or of the Loan Agreement, the Note or the other Loan Documents, (b) the release regardless of consideration, of the whole or any part of the Property, or (c) any agreement or stipulation by

Administrative Agent extending the time of payment or otherwise modifying or supplementing the terms of this Assignment, the Loan Agreement, the Note, or the other Loan Documents. Administrative Agent may resort for the payment and performance of the Debt to any other security held by Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender in such order and manner as Administrative Agent, in its sole discretion, may elect. Administrative Agent may take any action to recover the Debt, or any portion thereof, or to enforce any covenant hereof without prejudice to the right of Administrative Agent thereafter to enforce its rights under this Assignment. The rights of Administrative Agent under this Assignment shall be separate, distinct and cumulative and none shall be given effect to the exclusion of the others. No act of Administrative Agent shall be construed as an election to proceed under any one provision herein to the exclusion of any other provision.

Section 3.5 Bankruptcy. (a) Upon or at any time after the occurrence of an Event of Default, Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender shall have the right to proceed in its own name or in the name of Borrower in respect of any claim, suit, action or proceeding relating to the rejection of any Lease, including, without limitation, the right to file and prosecute, to the exclusion of Borrower, any proofs of claim, complaints, motions, applications, notices and other documents, in any case in respect of the lessee under such Lease under the Bankruptcy Code.

(b) If there shall be filed by or against Borrower a petition under the Bankruptcy Code, and Borrower, as lessor under any Lease, shall determine to reject such Lease pursuant to Section 365(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, then Borrower shall give Administrative Agent not less than ten (10) days' prior notice of the date on which Borrower shall apply to the bankruptcy court for authority to reject the Lease. Administrative Agent shall have the right, but not the obligation, to serve upon Borrower within such ten-day period a notice stating that (i) Administrative Agent demands that Borrower assume and assign the Lease to Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender pursuant to Section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code and (ii) Administrative Agent covenants to cure or provide adequate assurance of future performance under the Lease. If Administrative Agent serves upon Borrower the notice described in the preceding sentence, Borrower shall not seek to reject the Lease and shall comply with the demand provided for in clause (i) of the preceding sentence within thirty (30) days after the notice shall have been given, subject to the performance by Administrative Agent of the covenant provided for in clause (ii) of the preceding sentence.

ARTICLE 4 - NO LIABILITY, FURTHER ASSURANCES

Section 4.1 No Liability of Administrative Agent or Lender. This Assignment shall not be construed to bind Administrative Agent or Lender to the performance of any of the covenants, conditions or provisions contained in any Lease or Lease Guaranty or otherwise impose any obligation upon Administrative Agent or Lender. Administrative Agent or Lender shall not be liable for any loss sustained by Borrower resulting from Administrative Agent or Lender's failure to let the Property after an Event of Default or from any other act or omission of Administrative Agent or Lender in managing the Property after an Event of Default unless such loss is caused by the gross negligence, willful misconduct and/or bad faith of Administrative Agent or Lender. Administrative Agent or Lender shall not be obligated to perform or discharge any obligation, duty or liability under the Leases or any Lease Guaranties

or under or by reason of this Assignment and Borrower shall, and hereby agrees to, indemnify Administrative Agent or Lender for, and to hold Administrative Agent or Lender harmless from, any and all liability, loss or damage which may or might be incurred under the Leases, any Lease Guaranties or under or by reason of this Assignment and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever, including the defense of any such claims or demands which may be asserted against Administrative Agent or Lender by reason of any alleged obligations and undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in the Leases or any Lease Guaranties. Should Administrative Agent or Lender incur any such liability, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable attorneys' fees, shall be secured by this Assignment, the Security Instrument and the other Loan Documents and Borrower shall reimburse Administrative Agent or Lender therefor immediately upon demand and upon the failure of Borrower so to do Administrative Agent may or Lender may, at its option, declare all sums secured by this Assignment, the Security Instrument and the other Loan Documents immediately due and payable. This Assignment shall not operate to place any obligation or liability for the control, care, management or repair of the Property or any part thereof upon Administrative Agent or Lender, nor for the carrying out of any of the terms and conditions of the Leases or any Lease Guaranties; nor shall it operate to make Administrative Agent or Lender responsible or liable for any waste committed on the Property by the tenants or any other parties, or for any dangerous or defective condition of the Property including, without limitation, the presence of any Hazardous Substances (as defined in the Security Instrument), or for any negligence in the management, upkeep, repair or control of the Property resulting in loss or injury or death to any tenant, licensee, employee or stranger.

Section 4.2 No Mortgagee in Possession. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Administrative Agent or Lender a "mortgagee in possession" in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the Property by Administrative Agent or Lender. In the exercise of the powers herein granted Administrative Agent or Lender, no liability shall be asserted or enforced against Administrative Agent or Lender, all such liability being expressly waived and released by Borrower.

Section 4.3 Further Assurances. Borrower will, at the cost of Borrower, and without expense to Administrative Agent or Lender, do, execute, acknowledge and deliver all and every such further acts, conveyances, assignments, notices of assignments, transfers and assurances as Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender shall, from time to time, require for the better assuring, conveying, assigning, transferring and confirming unto Lender the property and rights hereby assigned or intended now or hereafter so to be, or which Borrower may be or may hereafter become bound to convey or assign to Lender, or for carrying out the intention or facilitating the performance of the terms of this Assignment or for filing, registering or recording this Assignment and, on demand, will execute and deliver and hereby authorizes Administrative Agent to execute in the name of Borrower to the extent Administrative Agent for the benefit of Lender may lawfully do so, one or more financing statements, chattel mortgages or comparable security instruments, to evidence more effectively the lien and security interest hereof in and upon the Leases.

ARTICLE 5 - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 5.1 Conflict of Terms. In case of any conflict between the terms of this Assignment and the terms of the Loan Agreement, the terms of the Loan Agreement shall prevail.

Section 5.2 No Oral Change. This Assignment and any provisions hereof may not be modified, amended, waived, extended, changed, discharged or terminated orally, or by any act or failure to act on the part of Borrower or Administrative Agent, but only by an agreement in writing signed by the party against whom the enforcement of any modification, amendment, waiver, extension, change, discharge or termination is sought.

Section 5.3 General Definitions. All capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the respective meanings set forth in the Loan Agreement. Unless the context clearly indicates a contrary intent or unless otherwise specifically provided herein, words used in this Assignment may be used interchangeably in singular or plural form and the word "Borrower" shall mean "each Borrower and any subsequent owner or owners of the Property or any part thereof or interest therein," the word "Lender" shall mean "Lender and any subsequent holder of the Note, the word "Note" shall mean "the Note and any other evidence of indebtedness secured by the Loan Agreement, the word "Property" shall include any portion of the Property and any interest therein, the phrases "attorneys' fees", "legal fees" and "counsel fees" shall include any and all attorney's, paralegal and law clerk fees and disbursements, including, but not limited to, fees and disbursements at the pre-trial, trial and appellate levels incurred or paid by Administrative Agent or Lender in protecting its interest in the Property, the Leases and the Rents and enforcing its rights hereunder; whenever the context may require, any pronouns used herein shall include the corresponding masculine, feminine or neuter forms, and the singular form of nouns and pronouns shall include the plural and vice versa.

Section 5.4 Inapplicable Provisions. If any term, covenant or condition of this Assignment is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, this Assignment shall be construed without such provision.

Section 5.5 Governing Law. This Assignment shall be governed in accordance with the terms and provisions of Section 10.3 of the Loan Agreement.

Section 5.6 Termination of Assignment. Upon payment in full of the Debt, this Assignment shall become and be automatically void and of no further effect.

Section 5.7 Notices. All notices or other written communications hereunder shall be delivered in accordance with Section 10.6 of the Loan Agreement.

Section 5.8 WAIVER OF TRIAL BY JURY. **BORROWER HEREBY WAIVES, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY ACTION, PROCEEDING OR COUNTERCLAIM, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE, RELATING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY TO THIS ASSIGNMENT, THE NOTE, OR THE OTHER LOAN DOCUMENTS OR ANY ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE AGENT, ITS**

OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, DIRECTORS OR AGENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Section 5.9 Exculpation. The provisions of Section 9.3 of the Loan Agreement are hereby incorporated by reference into this Assignment to the same extent and with the same force as if fully set forth herein.

Section 5.10 Successors and Assigns. This Assignment shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of Borrower and Administrative Agent and their respective successors and assigns forever.



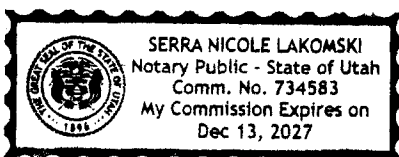
