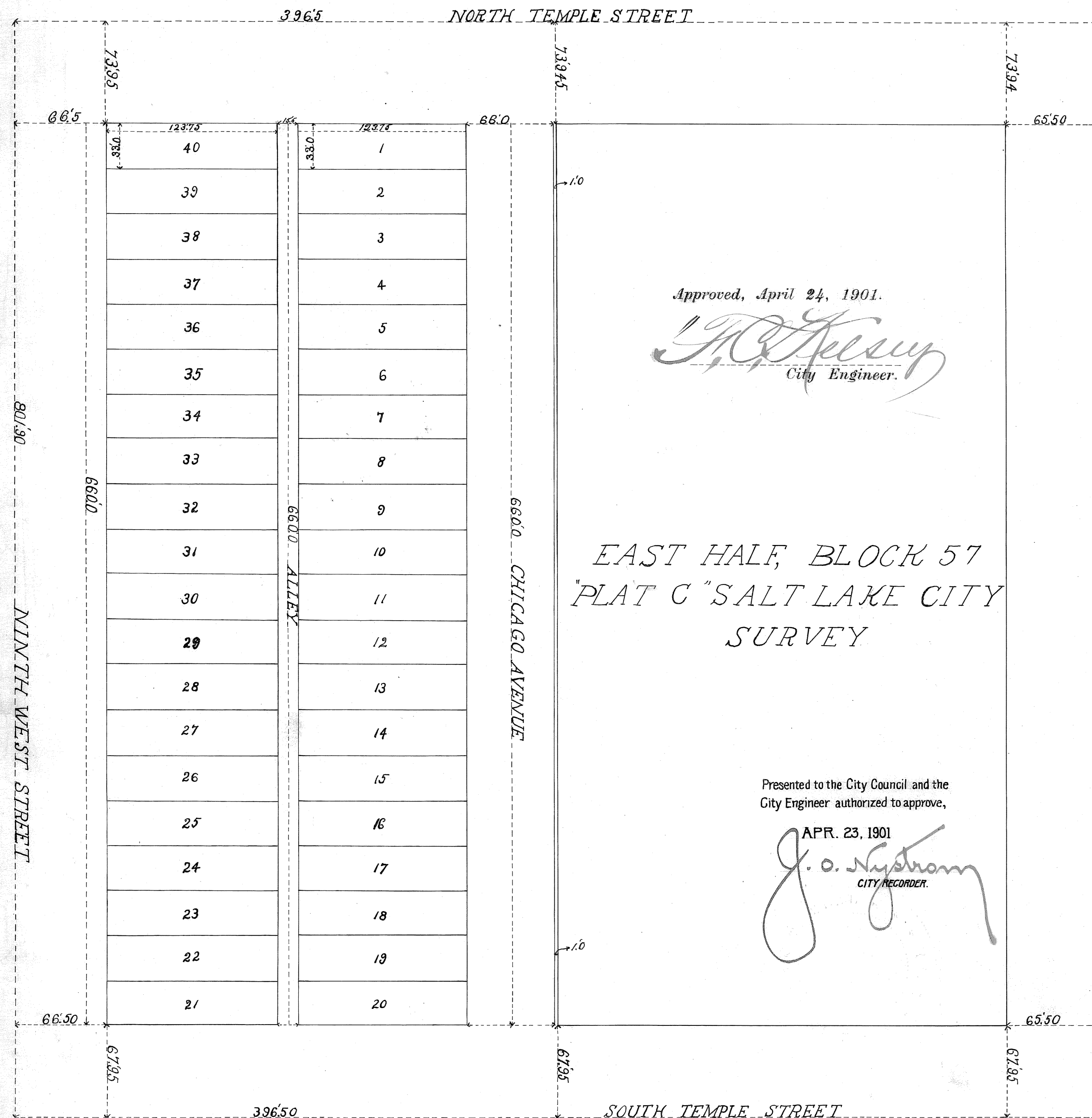


WESTERN SUBDIVISION OF BLOCK 57.



SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I hereby certify that the tract of land shown on this map and owned by the Western Loan and Savings Co. is bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point 73.95 South and 66.5 East of City monument at the intersection of Ninth West and North Temple Streets, thence running East 330.0, thence South 660.0, thence West 330.0, thence North 660.0 to the place of beginning, containing five (5) acres and known as lots 3, 4, 5, and 6 Block 57 Plat C; that I have by authority of the said owners thereof, subdivided the same into lots streets and alleys to be known as Western Subdivision of Block 57, that the same has been correctly staked out on the ground as represented hereon, and that the tape used in making the survey thereof was tested March 8th 1901, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance passed May 13th 1892 and at the time was in adjustment with the official standard prescribed in said ordinance.

Names and Dimensions of Parcels of Land Designated for Public Use.

Avenues.
Chicago Avenue 66.0 wide and 660.0 long running North and South.

Alleys.
One alley 15.5 wide running North and South through Block 57

Dimensions of Lots.
Lots 1 to 40 inclusive are 33' by 123.75.

Center Lines of Streets.
The center lines of Chicago Avenue and the Alley 15.5 wide are parallel with the center line of 9th West Street.
