

E A S E M E N T

C. J. BERTAGNOLLI, Granger of Weber County, State of Utah, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto HOOPER IRRIGATION COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement and right-of-way over and upon the following described premises situate in Weber County, Utah:

A part of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, U. S. Survey. Beginning at a point South 0 degrees 24' West 92.5 feet and West 60 feet, more or less, from the North east corner of said Section 26, said point being at the center of a gate on the West right-of-way line of the State Highway, and running thence west-erly and northerly over and across the grantors road to the south bank of the Hooper Canal. The purpose of this instrument being to convey a perpetual right-of-way to the Hooper Irrigation Company for the purpose of ingress and egress for maintaining, cleaning and operating the Hooper Canal, which crosses a portion of the grantors land, and to grant to the Hooper Irrigation Company the right to use the gate situated at a point heretofore described for the purposes set forth herein.


