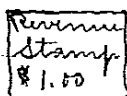

B-291-27 of said State in such case made and provided,

B-267-30 And whereas, the said John M. Macfarlane has paid

B-267-21 for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Five Hundred and Forty (\$540.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

Now, Therefore I William Spry, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power



and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said John M. Macfarlane and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Washington, State aforesaid, to wit:

The South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22; the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$); the North West quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$), the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North East quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26; and the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 35 in Township 38 South Range 11 West of the Salt Lake meridian containing Three Hundred & sixty acres according to the said certificate.

To Have and To Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said John M. Macfarlane and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof, and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
