

F. N. Cameron, and Peter Bosone and Teresa Bosone, his wife, Grantors, of Salt Lake & Carbon Counties, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 4 towers or poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Carbon County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Commencing 65 ft. North of a point 1320 ft. West of S. 1/4 corner Sec. 8, Tp. 13 S., R. 9 E., S. L. M., thence running N. 58° 05' W. 40 ft., thence N. 67° 27' W., 1375 feet to West boundary of Grantor's land.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges, incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
