WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vernal, Utah, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Alex Crystal
